L6D01	Advanced OSH Management Principles in Organizations — develops advanced understanding of OSH legal frameworks and management principles, including application, development, appraisal and implications of different approaches.	13 credits	60 GLH
L6D02	OSH Integration within an Organization — enables learners to critically appraise OSH performance, understand internal/external influences on OSH decision-making, and develop organization-wide recommendations.	13 credits	50 GLH

Who should take this course?

This qualification is for professionals whose role involves managing OSH policy, procedures and practice — typically reporting to, or sitting within, the senior leadership team. It is aimed at experienced OSH practitioners moving into strategic, leadership-level responsibility.

Entry requirements

- **No mandatory entry requirements.**
- **Strongly recommended:** IOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health Practice, or an equivalent IOSH-accredited qualification and/or relevant experience — this level of prior learning is assumed.
- **Minimum age:** 19 years or above

IOSH Level 6 Benefits

- **Career progression:** on successful completion, learners meet the academic requirement for CertIOSH.
- **Dual accreditation:** also approved by the Institute of Leadership & Management (ILM) as a pathway to Member grade (MInstLM).



- **Chartered pathway:** this Diploma is a recognised step toward Chartered Membership (CMIOSH).
- **Regulated and quality-assured:** Ofqual-regulated.
- **Real workplace application:** assessments are built around the learner's own organisation

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How long does the course take?

The qualification represents 380 total learning hours (155 guided + 225 self-study), delivered across 24 guided sessions. [Weekly]

Do I need any qualifications to join?

No mandatory entry requirements, though the IOSH Level 3 Certificate (or equivalent experience) is strongly recommended, as this level of prior knowledge is assumed.

What will I walk away with?

The IOSH Level 6 Diploma in OSH Leadership and Management — a Level 6, Ofqual-regulated qualification — plus eligibility to apply for Graduate/Certified IOSH Membership and ILM Membership.

Is this qualification recognised?

Yes. It is regulated by Ofqual, accredited by IOSH against its Competency Framework, and separately approved by the Institute of Leadership & Management.

How is it assessed?

Through ongoing formative assessment plus three IOSH-set summative assignments based on the learner's own workplace: a Technical Evaluation, an OSH Strategic Proposal, and a Self-Reflection report.
